CITIZENSHIP CEREMONIES

Policy 1.6

That as a matter of policy, with regard to the Conduct of Citizenship Ceremonies:

- 1 The Chief Executive Officer, Shire President and Deputy Shire President are authorised to conduct citizenship ceremonies for the Shire of Wiluna
- 2 The timing and venue of the citizenship ceremony and the authorised person to conduct the ceremony is to be determined by the Chief Executive Officer in liaison/consultation with the person to be granted their citizenship
- 3 In the event that the Chief Executive Officer, Shire President or Deputy Shire President are not be available on the date determined under subparagraph two (2), the Chief Executive Officer is to authorise a Councillor that is available, to conduct the ceremony.
4. The attire of attendees at Citizenship Ceremonies should reflect the significance of the occasion and as such smart casual or national/cultural dress shall be deemed to be the acceptable dress code.
